 months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first
 examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

Student's Right to Cancel

The Student has the right to cancel this Contract and obtain a full refund of charges paid, through attendance at the first class-session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. If the Student wishes to exercise their Right to Cancel, they must return all handouts and written materials that were provided when the Student received their student packet.

Earned Tuition:

- The greater of \$500 or 25% of the *Tuition Price*, is considered earned upon *Course Signup* and is non-refundable after the cancellation period expires. This amount is considered earned whether it has been collected or not.
- Two months after the *Signup Date*, the *Tuition* is considered earned in full and no portion will be available for refund. Any refund must be requested in writing (paper, email, or text message) prior to this time. Refund requests sent in after this time will be considered invalid.
- Each hour a student books class (Bookings) is considered earned (Earned Hours) at the start time of the class. If a student does not come to a class that they booked, the hour is still considered earned and is non-refundable. Any Bookings that are cancelled or rescheduled in accordance with the Bookings Policy will be credited back to the student or changed to the rescheduled date/time.
- Once the student has earned their commercial driver's license, the entire *Tuition* is considered *Earned Tuition*. Any unused training hours, whether they were previously booked or not, are forfeited at that time. If you are not able to finish all of your *Training Hours* by your test date, you may request a new test date to allow you to finish all of your *Training Hours*.
- There is no refund for any *Training Hours* that are not completed.
- As stated in the Safety and Rules Contract, no refunds will be given to any student who
 has been suspended or expelled from Source Trucking Academy.
- Students have one year from the *Signup Date* to complete all their *Classes*. Any remaining *Training Hours* will be forfeited at that time. No refunds will be given for any *Classes* not completed prior to the one-year limit.
- Online Classes are included as part of the curriculum for each course. These Classes are required to be completed outside of the normal class hours. Each online class, once started, is considered one Earned Hour.

Process to Obtain a Refund:

The Student is eligible for a refund if they meet the following criteria:

- 1. It must not be more than two months since the Signup Date.
- 2. The amount already paid must be more than the *Earned Tuition* amount.
- 3. The Student must not be currently suspended or expelled from Source Trucking Academy.
- 4. The Student must submit in writing (paper, email, or text message) to an employee of Source Trucking Academy that they would like to withdraw their enrollment and receive a refund.
- 5. Source Trucking Academy will respond with an official academy Request to Withdraw Form that must be signed by the Student and returned.
- 6. Finally, the student must sign a Refund Receipt when they receive the refund.

In the event a student used the School's financing program, all contracts for any further payments will be cancelled upon signing of the Refund Receipt. The Student will not be charged any cancellation fees.

If the Student obtained an outside loan to pay for their educational program, the Student will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund. If the Student was eligible for a loan guaranteed by the federal or state government and the Student defaults on the loan, both of the following may occur:

- 1. The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student including applying any income tax refund to which the person is entitled to reduce the balance owed on the loan.
- 2. The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government assistance until the loan is repaid.

If during enrollment, a student becomes ineligible to receive their Commercial Driver's License, all of the above Refund Policy remains in effect and will still apply.
